Lynn Masters, an accomplished and internationally recognized automotive artist, is the feature artist for the 2007 Concours d'Elegance Las Vegas. Due to her ability to capture the sheer passion and energy of her chosen subject's essence Lynn was selected to produce the poster art for the 2007 event. In her first juried show, the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Invitational Art Show, Lynn received the "Award of Excellence." She has also been featured on the nationally televised show "Dream Car Garage," and was honored to participate in Michigan's prestigious Meadowbrook Concours d'Elegance in 2006 where she was the only women selected out of the 14 artists chosen internationally.

Concours d'Elegance events began over 100 years ago in the parks of Paris, the Rivera and other elegant resort towns of Europe. The rich and famous of European society gathered to socialize and celebrate the latest automobiles and women's fashions as unique art forms that graced their stylish lives as much as the homes in which they lived and the banquets and dinner parties they attended. They called these events Concours d'Elegance, a phrase that, when translated, quite literally meant 'competition of excellence'.

The Concours made its American debut in 1950 in Pebble Beach, CA. Today there are several dozen shows that have adopted the Concours name. This is the World premier of the Concours d'Elegance in Las Vegas.
